Executive Summary

The purpose of this document is to present the methodology and procedures that will be used within SHAREWORK to recruit and involve human participants in research activities for the following purposes: measuring Job Quality in the use-cases, maximising the acceptance of innovation by end-users, optimising the Human-Robot Collaboration (HRC) systems and interface, training operators and validating the usability and safety of the SHAREWORK solution. This document also provides ethical guidelines, which shall be followed by each partner. These guidelines will ensure that ethics issues and general conduct regarding human participants are considered and implemented properly in the project's procedures. SHAREWORK partners will have the responsibility for ensuring that any activity involving human participation and that is carried out within the Work Package (WP) that they lead, complies with these guidelines.
